### House White Wines

- Branch Creek Chardonnay/Semillon (Australia) €19.00  
Fresh flavours of white peach and tropical fruit make this wine easy drinking for any occasion.
- Chilensis Sauvignon Blanc (Chile) €21.00  
A light, crisp and zesty wine. Very easy drinking.
- Les Roucas Chardonnay (France) €22.00  
This offering is pale gold in colour with intense flavours of ripe apple and pear.

### House Red Wines

- Branch Creek Shiraz (Australia) €19.00  
Easy drinking packed with delicious plum and red berry flavours with a warming hint of spice.
- Chilensis Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile) €21.00  
An expressive wine with dark fruit flavours with strawberry, plum and strong notes of cassis.
- Campobello Chianti Superior (Italy) €26.00  
This wine has deep black cherry and blackberry fruit, ripe tannins and fresh, juicy acidity.

### White Wine Selection

- Pulpit Rock (South Africa) €25.00  
A dry white wine where tropical aromas dominate on the nose.
- Gabriella Pinot Grigio (Italy) €27.00  
This has a wonderful cream soda, crisp, and clean and fresh appeal.
- Spy Valley Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) €31.00  
This classic sauvignon has characters of gooseberry and asparagus, with ripe melon.
- Fishcage Semillon /Sauvignon Blanc (Australia) €32.00  
This Australian wine has aromas of nettle, lime pith and lemon sorbet.
- Prinz Von Hessen H Riesling (Germany) €36.00  
A juicy wine with a fresh, fruity smell and reminds of apple, citrus, grapefruit and a little peach.
- Lupe Chalot Macon Lugney (France) €40.00  
In the nose, it has a good fruitiness with notes of peach, apricot and white flowers.
- Sancerre De Millet (France) €45.00  
Earthy in taste with a flint finish typical of the region.
- Chablis De Valeys (France) €48.00  
Fruit driven on the nose, this wine has nice breadth on the medium-bodied palate.

This supple wine offers aromas of red fruits and spices giving silky tannins and a velvety finish.	
Alain Jaume Cotes Du Rhone (France)	€34.00
Wide aromatic range: wild raspberries, blackcurrant, blackberries, liquorice and white pepper.	
Don David Malbec (Argentina)	€30.00
A rich red with full body and flavours of blackberry, plum, black raspberry, cedar and spice.	
Murial Rioja Crianza (Spain)	€28.00
Ruby red, nose with a lot of oak, blackcurrant, spicy, some vanilla.	
Fishcage Cabernet /Merlot (Australia)	€32.00
Medium brick red. Aromas of blackberry, rhubarb and tomato bush.	
Old Coach Rd Pinot Noir (New Zealand)	€37.00
Smooth and velvety alongside the dried herb and spicy fruit characters and oak.	
Lupe Chalot Fluire (France)	€42.00
The nose unveils a beautiful fruit and a subtle blend of raspberry and strawberry.	
Les Abeilles St Emillion Grand Cru (France)	€49.00
An appealing nose of intense floral notes, ripe red fruit and spices.	

## Connoisseur Whites

Chateau De Vivers Premier Cru (France)	€74.00
A glorious white. Very fresh, its nose yields a mixture of citrus and grapes with a delicately floral touch.	
Ravoire Chateauneuf Du Pape (France)	€82.00
Flowery notes of honeysuckle, lime fruit and vine peach. Fresh and ample mouth finishing with aromas that reveal the mineral notes of this wine.	
Champs De Cris Pouilly Fume (France)	€50.00
Dry, fruity, white, this wine is full-bodied and reflects the inimitable taste of the Pouilly land.	
Lupe Chalot Mercury (France)	€52.00
Elegant nose opening up to aromas of white fruits, vanilla with well integrated new oak.	
Puligny Montrachet Chalot (France)	€102.00
Delicate and intense with notes of honey, hawthorn and candied orange, it is fleshy with a body well-balance on discreet new oak.	
Terras Guada O Rosal (Spain)	€55.50
Combination of apple compote and fresh grape, also subtle notes of mature peach.	
Scott Chardonnay (California)	€64.00
Warm aromas of apple pie and butterscotch, flavours are velvety rich of pear, caramel apple and pineapple.

In the nose it's fresh with black fruit including myrtle, blackberry and a hint of cherry brandy.	
Santenay Lupe (France)	€59.00

Ruby colour with glints of cherry.

Ravoire Chateauneuf Du Pape (France)	€78.00
Aromas of red fruits, spices, leading on to fragrances of truffles and liquorice.	
Ch Cissac Cru Haut Medoc (France)	€64.00
A full purple red colour, fresh ripe dark fruit nose with hints of vanilla and tobacco.	
Ch Corbin Michote St Emillion Grand Cru (France)	€106.00
Flavours reminiscent of dark chocolate, blackcurrant, plums, cassis and notes of earth and tobacco.	
Murial Grand Reserva Rioja (Spain)	€55.00
An aromatic explosion of fine oak, vanilla, fine herbs and spices.	
St Antonio Amarone (Italy)	€95.00
Hints of ripe red fruit, spicy aromas of liquorice, black pepper and hints of chocolate.	
Don Amado Special Edition (Chile)	€86.00
Complex aroma with notes of black fruits, spices with fine coco and vanilla.	
Compagnes Pinotage (South Africa)	€52.00
A dark wine with intense spice, plum, mocha, cherry and dark chocolate aromas.	
Rutherford Ranch Zinfandel (California)	€50.00
A complex bouquet of ripe boysenberries, black pepper and French vanilla.

A medium bodied wine of a rich dark pink colour with soft luscious fruits and an off-dry palate.

Fresh, bubbly, perhaps a bit of sweetness but not too much.	
Champagne Pannier (France)	€68.00
Grape varieties: chardonnay for finesse, pinot noir for structure & pinot meunier for delicate fruit.	
Bollinger Champagne (France)	€110.00
Well-delineated aromas of honey, brioche, roasted nuts, orange zest, flowers and peaches.
